Saint Benet Biscop, is one of the

Congregation. He lived from 628–
689 in Northumbria and was the
first Bishop of Wearmouth.

of Glasgow, is one of the Patrons
of the Archdiocese of Liverpool.
He died in 612.

St Maurus and St Placid were Monk
disciples of St Benedict (480-547).
Placid fell into a lake and Maurus
was sent to rescue him by Benedict
who had a vision of him drowning.
Placid said he saw Benedict above
Maurus as he was being rescued.
