SAINTS OF THE WEEK

SAINT BONAVENTURE 15 JULY

Born in 1218 in Tuscany. He
studied philosophy and theology in
Paris. He became Minister General
of the Franciscan Order and ruled
with great wisdom and prudence.
He later became Cardinal Bishop
of Albano and wrote many works
in philosophy and theology.
He died at Lyons in the year 1274.

SAINT CAMILLUS 14 JULY

Born near Chieti in Abruzzi in
1550, he was a soldier until his
conversion to religious life.
After his ordination as a Priest
he dedicated himself to care for
the sick and founded a
religious congregation which
set up Hospitals.
He died at Rome in 1614.
