## SAINTS OF THE WEEK

### Saint Joachim and Saint Anne 26 JULY

Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Veneration of Saint Anne dates from the sixth Century; that of Saint Joachim is more recent.

### Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus 29 JULY

Martha, Mary and Lazarus were the sisters of Lazarus, who was raised from the dead by Jesus.

Martha is renowned for her hospitality, Mary for listening at the feet of Jesus.

## Saint Ignatius of Layola

31 JULY

Born in the year 1491 at Layola in Northern Spain.

His early life was led at Court and in the army, and later he was converted to a life of holiness.

He studied theology at Paris and gathered companions around him, and afterwards at Rome he formed the Society of Jesus.

He exercised a very fruitful apostolate by his written work and by the formation of his disciples who were outstanding in the reform of the Church.

He died at Rome in the year 1556.
