**BUILDING WORKS**

Some may have noticed the Cherry Picker, the Scaffolding at the Priory and the Scaffolding at the north side of the Church. These are parts of Maintenance and Repair works having to be carried out as a result of a compulsory Quinquennial Survey.

We were told that 84 items "must be dealt with within twelve months".....and that was in 2007!

The cost, plus new railings for the Path through the wood to Alder Lane, will come to around 50,000.

The good news is that the money is there – the bad news – it is still in Parishoners' pockets! No appeal will be conducted — apart from this Notice.
