**SAINTS OF THE WEEK
Saint Maximilian Kolbe**

14 August

Born in January 1894 in Poland, he became a Conventual Franciscan Friar. He was sent to Auschwitz Concentration Camp during World War II. In 1941 he volunteered to die in place of a stranger in the gas chambers.

He was canonised in 1982 and declared Patron Saint of drug addicts, political prisoners, journalists and the Pro-Life movement.

Saint Stephen of Hungary

16 August

Born in Hungary in 969, Stephen became King of Hungary at the age of 13. He strengthened the Church and established many Dioceses before he died in 1038.
