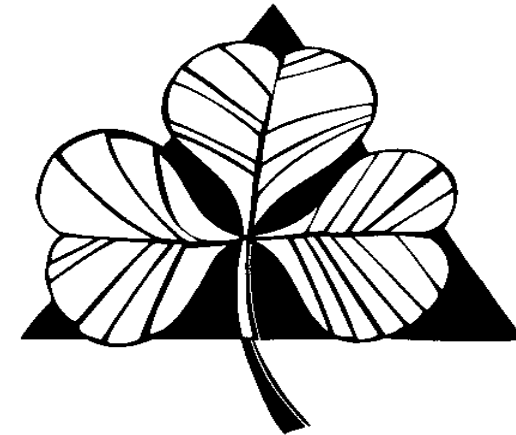

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

SAINT JOHN RIGBY

18 June

Was born in the Parish at Harrock
Hall. He entered service, as a
Steward, in Cambridgeshire in
1595. He was arrested, tried and
condemned for being reconciled
to the Catholic Church in 1600.

He was hanged, drawn and
quartered on 21 June 1600.

SAINT ALOYSIUS

21 June

Born in the year 1568, in
Lombardy. Giving up his
birthright, he entered the
Society of Jesus.

He worked with the sick, where he
was stricken with the plague and
died in the year 1591.
