GIVING

Thank you to all who have so kindly reviewed their giving as a result of the request, made six weeks ago. Donors were asked to make an annual review, on or around **6 April** of their giving to the Church – Loose Plate, Gift Aid Envelopes or Standing Orders.

Some had not done so in the last ten years yet in that time the price of a pint of beer has risen by 55%, Petrol has risen by 70% and the Church heating and lighting bills have risen by 180%.

In the same period of time, has your giving been reviewed?

This year's Insurance Bill, recently arrived (not including the car) is for £3,125.35.

The Gas Bill for the Church Heating for December, January and February, also recently received, is for £2,052.88.

As a result, next winter the Church heating will be reduced from 44 hours per week to 30 hours per week.

£50,000 APPEAL

Last week it was written that £2,02500 was received for our £50,000 appeal. If only this was a misprint for £2,025.00!

PAINTING

The Church painting is now complete – with the exception of the SW corner which will be completed in June once the external wall has been sealed. Our thanks to Michael Spooner for good efficient work.
