SAINTS MARY, MARTHA AND LAZARUS

29 July

Mary and Martha were sisters of Lazarus who was raised from the dead by Jesus.

Martha is renowned for her hospitality and Mary for listening at the feet of Jesus.

SAINT IGNATIUS OF LAYOLA

31 July

Founder of the Jesuits. He had a Damascus experience at the Benedictine Monastery of Montserrat.

SAINT ALPHONSUS

1 August

Born in Naples in the year 1696, he studied both Civil and Canon law, becoming a Priest and later founding the Redemptorist Order. He died in Nocera dei Pagani in 1787.
