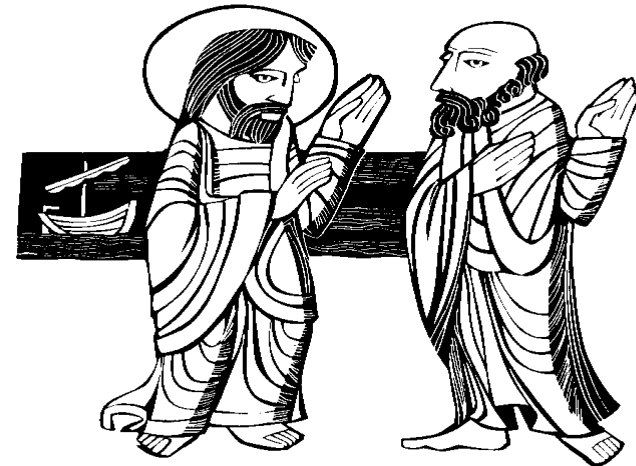

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

SAINT THOMAS 3 JULY

Thomas is renowned among the Apostles chiefly because of his lack of faith which was dispelled when the risen Christ appeared to him.

He proclaimed what is in fact the Easter faith of the Church when he said "My Lord and my God". Nothing certain is known of his life apart from what is given in the Gospels, but tradition has it that he preached to the people of India.

From the sixth century a feast of the translation of the relics has been kept at Edessa on 3 July.

SAINT ELIZABETH OF PORTUGAL 4 JULY

Born of the Royal family of Aragon in the year 1271. As a girl she was given in marriage to the King of Portugal, by whom she had two sons.

She overcame many difficulties by prayer and works of charity. When her husband died she gave her worldly goods to the poor and took the habit of the Third Order of Saint Francis. She died in 1336.

SAINT MARIA GORETTI

Virgin and Martyr

6 JULY

Born in Ancona in Italy of a poor family in the year 1890. She spent her childhood near Nettuno in poverty, helping her mother in the domestic chores. She was a religious girl and was much given to prayer.

In the year 1902, while defending her chastity against a man attempting to violate her, she preferred to die rather than give way.
