SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Saint Gregory the Great

3 September

Born in Rome about the year 540. He became Prefect of the City, then entered a Monastery, was ordained Deacon and performed the office of a Papal Legate to Constantinople.

On 3 September 590 he became Pope and showed himself a true pastor in his administration, his care for the poor and in spreading and consolidating the faith. In addition he wrote many works on morals and faith.

He was responsible for the re-evangelisation of England.
