**SAINTS OF THE WEEK**

**Saint Justin**

**1 June**

Born at the beginning of the second Century in Samaria, he was a philosopher and wrote in defence of religion. He opened a school in Rome and took part in public disputations, He suffered a martyrs death in 165.

**Saint Charles Lwanga**

**3 June**

During the years 1885—1887, many Christians were killed in Uganda by King Mwangi in hatred of religion. Some of these were the King's personal attendants including Charles and his 21 companions who were killed by the sword or burned to death.

**Saint Boniface**

**5 June**

Born in England about the year 673. He became a monk in the Monastery of Exeter and in 719 he went to Germany to preach. He was a great success, but was killed by pagans in 754.

**Saint Norbert**

**6 June**

Born about the year 1080. He became Canon of the Cathedral of Xanten, in 1115, he became a Priest, preaching the word of God across Germany and France.

He laid the foundations of the Premonstratensian Order and with help from his companions set up a number of Monasteries. He eventually became Archbishop of Magdeburg and died in the year 1134.
