**SAINT JOHN RIGBY**

**18 June**

Was born in the Parish at  
Harrock Hall. He entered  
service, as a Steward, in  
Cambridgeshire in 1595.

He was arrested, tried and  
condemned for being reconciled  
to the Catholic Church in 1600.  
He was hanged, drawn and  
quartered on 21 June 1600.
