SAINTS OF THE WEEK

SAINT HENRY 13 July

Born in Bavaria in the year 973. He succeeded his father as Duke of Bavaria and was later elected as Holy Roman Emperor.

He was outstanding in his reforms in the Church and for his encouragement of missionary activity.

He set up many dioceses and founded monasteries.

He died in the year 1024 and was canonized by Eugene III in 1146.

SAINT CAMILLUS OF LELLIS

14 July

Saint Camillus was a soldier, who after his conversion to religious life, dedicated himself to looking after the sick. After being ordained Priest he continued his work, setting up hospitals. He is the Patron Saint of Nurses and the Sick. He died in 614.

SAINT BONAVENTURE

Bishop and Doctor of the Church 15 July

Born about the year 1218 at Bagnoregio in Tuscany. He studied philosophy and theology at Paris, where he gained his masters degree, and then taught the students of the Order.

He became Minister General of the Franciscan Order and ruled with great wisdom and prudence, and later became Bishop of Albano.

He wrote many influential works in philosophy and theology and died at Lyons in the year 1274
