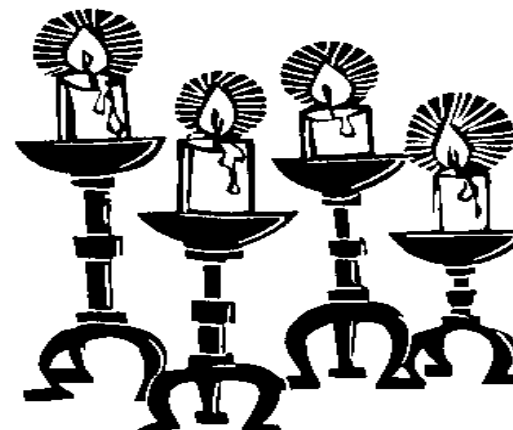

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Tuesday 2 February

The Presentation of the Lord

On the fortieth day after birth, the
parents of Jesus took the child to
the Temple to complete Mary's
ritual purification, and to perform
the redemption of the firstborn son.
They took the option provided for
poor people (those who could not
afford a lamb) sacrificing "a pair of
turtledoves, or two young pigeons".

Wednesday 3 February St Blaise

Saint Blaise was bishop of Sebaste
and was martyred, probably early
in the fourth century. Devotion to
him spread throughout the Church
during the Middle Ages.
He is particularly invoked for
of the throat.

Friday 5 February St Agatha

Agatha was martyred at Catania
in Sicily, probably during the
persecution of Decius (250-253).
Devotion to her was widespread in
the early Church. She is mentioned
in the Roman Canon of the Mass.

Saturday 6 February

St Paul Miki and Companions

Paul Miki was born in Japan
between 1564 and 1566. He
joined the Society of Jesus and
preached the gospel to the
Japanese people. When a
persecution of the Catholics arose
he was arrested together with
twenty-five others. Mocked and
tortured, they were taken to
Nagasaki on 5 February 1597,
bound to crosses and speared.
