SAINTS OF THE WEEK

14 July

Saint Camillus

Saint Camillus was a soldier, who
after his conversion to religious
life, dedicated himself to looking
after the sick.

After being ordained Priest he
continued his work,
setting up hospitals.
He is the Patron Saint of Nurses
and the Sick. He died in 614.

11 July

**Saint Benedict
Abbot and Patron of Europe**

Born in Norcia in Umbria about
the year 480.

After studying at Rome, he led
a life of solitude in Subiaco
and disciples gathered around
him.

He then went to Monte Cassino.
Here he founded a well known
Monastery and wrote his Rule, as
a result of which, he has been
known as the father of
Monasticism in the West.

He died on 21 March 547,
but from the Eighth Century
he has also been venerated
on 11 July, the Feast Day of
Saint Benedict — Patron of Europe
