SAINTS OF THE WEEK

25 July Saint James the Great
He was born at Bethsaida, the son of Zebedee and the brother of the Apostle John. He was present when Christ performed His most important miracles. He was killed by King Herod about the year 42 and is venerated especially at Compostella in Spain where there is a magnificent Church dedicated in his honour.

26 July

Saint Joachim and Saint Anne
Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The veneration of Saint Anne dates from the sixth Century, that of Saint Joachim is more recent.

29 July

Saint Martha, Saint Mary and Saint Lazarus
Mary and Martha were sisters of Lazarus who was raised from the dead by Jesus. Martha is renowned for her hospitality and Mary for listening at the feet of Jesus.

31 July

Saint Ignatius
Founder of the Jesuits. A soldier who had a Damascus experience at the Benedictine Monastery of Montserrat.
