SAINTS OF THE WEEK

28 June Saint Irenaeus

A disciple of Saint Polycarp, he
was made Priest in 177 and
shortly afterwards was
made Bishop.
In his writings he defended the
Catholic Faith against the gnostics,
he was martyred in 200.

29 June

Saint Peter and Saint Paul

Peter, leader of the Apostles, was
called Simon. Andrew, his brother,
introduced him to Christ who
changed his name to Peter.
Peter and Andrew were both
fishermen.

St Peter, appointed the Leader of
the infant Church subsequently
denies Christ three times.

Paul was born a Jew named Saul,
he took part in the stoning of
Stephen, the first Martyr.

He saw a vision of Christ on the
way to Damascus, which changed
the course of his life.

His name was changed to Paul
and he was martyred in
67 AD in Rome.
