**16 August**

**Saint Stephen of Hungary**

Born in Hungary in 969, Stephen became King of Hungary at the age of 13. Keeping strictly to the laws of the Church, he established many dioceses.

**18 August**

**Saint Helen**

Mother of Emperor Constantine, She became a Christian when Constantine legalised Christianity

**20 August**

**Saint Bernard**

**Abbot and Doctor of the Church**  
Born in France in 1090, he travelled throughout Europe preaching peace and Unity, writing many works of theology. He died in 1153.
