23 August

Saint Rose of Lima

Born in Lima in Peru in 1586, Rose took the habit of the Third Order of Saint Dominic making great progress in penance and Mystical contemplation.

She died on 24 August 1617.

24 August

Saint Bartholomew

He was led to Jesus by the Apostle Phillip and after the Ascension, he preached the Gospel in India where he suffered Martyrdom.

Saint Bartholomew is the Patron of Father Gordon's family.

27 August

Saint Monica

Born in 331, she was the mother of Saint Augustine of Hippo. She was unceasing in her prayers to God.
