SAINTS OF THE WEEK

30 August
Saint Edmund Arrowsmith SJ

Jesuit Priest and Martyr. Born in Haydock in Lancashire, he was ordained Priest in 1612. He joined the Society of Jesus.

He was arrested at Brindle, 16 Miles North East from Parbold. He was sentenced to death for being a seminary Priest and was left chained for two days without food.

He was promised his life would be spared if he renounced his faith. He was executed at Lancaster on 28 August 1628.

A Portrait and a hand relic survives in St Oswald at Ashton in Makerfield, where cures believed to be miraculous have been reported.

3 September

Saint Gregory the Great

Born in Rome about the year 540. He became Prefect of the City, then entered a Monastery, was ordained Deacon and performed the office of a Papal Legate to Constantinople.

On 3 September 590 he became Pope and showed himself a true pastor in his administration, his care for the poor and in spreading and consolidating the faith. In addition he wrote many works on morals and faith. He was responsible for the re-evangelisation of England.

Non Angli sed Angeli

He died on 12 March 604.
