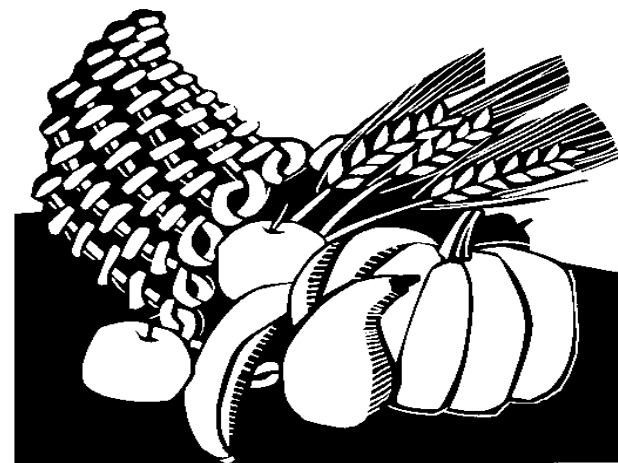

**Saint Vincent de Paul**

**27 September**

Born in Gascony in France in the year 1581.

He completed his studies and was ordained Priest and became Parish Priest in Paris.

He founded the Congregation of the Mission (Vincentians) for the purpose of the spiritual formation of the Clergy and the relief of the Poor, and with the help of Saint Louise de Marillac he also founded the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity.

He died in Paris in the year 1660.
