CREMATED ASHES

The Holy See has recently directed (25 October) that Cremated Ashes

1. May only be buried in a Church, a Cemetery or other Sacred Ground.
2. May never be scattered — anywhere — not even in Church Grounds.
3. May never be stored at home or in any other place that is not designated as Sacred.
4. May not be divided into portions for individual members of the family.
5. May not have portions included in lockets etc.
