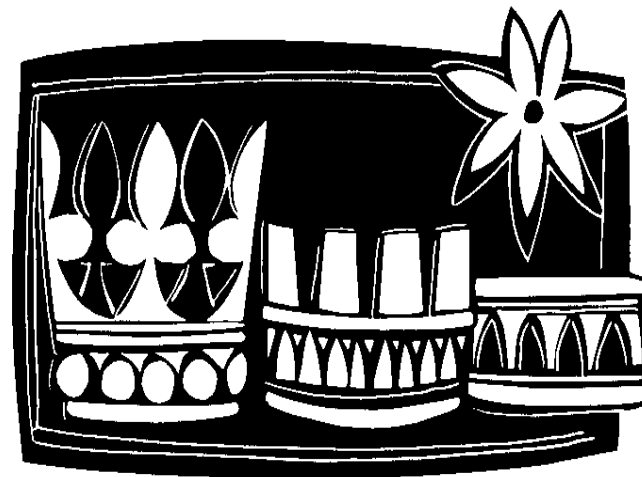

**SAINTS OF THE WEEK**

**11 January**

**Saint Aelred**

Saint Aelred of Rievaulx was a Cistercian Abbot and writer. He was born in 1110, educated at Durham and joined the household of David I, King of Scotland.

He later became Abbot of Rievaulx and under his rule the number of Monks increased to 150 Monks and 500 lay brothers., which was the largest of its time in England.

He wrote a great many works and died on the 12 January 1167 at Rievaulx.

He was never formally canonised, however the Cistercians set his Feast Day in 1476.

**12 January St Benet Biscop OSB**

Born in 628, he travelled extensively before founding and becoming the first Abbot of Wearmouth.

He ran his community based on the Rule of Saint Benedict and the seventeen Monasteries he had visited.

In 682, he founded the Monastery of Jarrow, which was dedicated to Saint Paul. Biscop collected an extensive library which assisted Saint Bede with his achievements.

**14 January**

**Saint Kentigern**

Monk and Bishop, there are many legends but few known facts about Kentigern.

Patron of Glasgow and secondary Patron of Liverpool. Until the 11th Century the Kingdom of Strathclyde incorporated Cumbria.
