SAINTS OF THE WEEK

31 July

Saint Ignatius

Founder of the Jesuits.
A soldier who had a Damascus experience at the Benedictine Monastery of Montserrat.

1 August

Saint Alphonsus CSSR

Born in Naples in the year 1696, he studied both civil and Canon law, becoming a Priest and later founding the Redemptorist Order. He died in Nocera dei Pagani in 1787.

4 August

The Curé of Ars

Saint John Marie Vianney
St John Marie Vianney was born in Lyons in 1786. After overcoming tremendous difficulties he was ordained Priest. He became Parish Priest (Curé) of Ars. He was renowned for his forthright preaching, personal mortification, prayer and charity. People flocked to him from all sides for his Confessional advice. The Curé d'Ars died in 1859. He is the patron Saint of Parish Priests.

2 August

Saint Sativola

The Patron Saint of Millers. The Ainscough family who built Our Lady and All saints Church were Millers. Saint Sativola appears on our Rose Window
