SAINTS OF THE WEEK

5 February

St Agatha

Agatha was martyred at Catania in Sicily, probably during the persecution of Decius (250-253). Devotion to her was widespread in the early Church. She is mentioned in the Roman Canon of the Mass.

6 February

St Paul Miki and Companions

Paul Miki was born in Japan between 1564 and 1566. He joined the Society of Jesus and preached the gospel to the Japanese people.

When a persecution of the Catholics arose he was arrested together with twenty-five others. Mocked and tortured, they were taken to Nagasaki on 5 February 1597, bound to crosses and speared.
