SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Saint Anselm

21 April

Bishop and Doctor of the Church

Born in the year 1033 in Aosta in Piedmont, he entered the Benedictine Order in the Monastery of Le Bec in France. He taught theology, he then went to England where he was chosen to be Archbishop of Canterbury.

There he strenuously fought for the freedom of the Church and was twice condemned to exile. He is renowned for his writings, particularly in mystical theology.

He died in the year 1109.
