SAINTS OF THE WEEK

**Saint Stanislaus
Bishop and Martyr**

11 April

Born in the town of Szczepanow in
Poland about the year 1030.
He studied in Paris and became
Priest in 1070.

He became the Bishop of Krakow
and ruled the Diocese as a good
shepherd, helping the poor and
making a visitation of his clergy
every year.

He fearlessly rebuked the King
Boeslav on land issues and
treatment of his people and was
murdered by him in 1097.

Saint Stanislaus is usually depicted
as a Bishop holding a sword, the
instrument of his Martyrdom.
