### Saint Pius X

Born in Riese in the Province of Venice in the year 1835. He became a priest and excelled in the duties given to him. After being first bishop of Mantua and then Patriarch of Venice, he was elected Pope in the year 1903.

He made it his object in his pontificate to restore all things in Christ, and he did this by his simplicity, his poverty and his fortitude. He renewed the true Christian life among the faithful and he fought strenuously against the errors which were sweeping through the Church at the time.

He died on 20 August 1914

## 23 August      Saint Rose of Lima

Born in Lima in Peru in 1586, Rose took the habit of the Third Order of Saint Dominic making great progress in penance and Mystical contemplation. She died on 24 August 1617.
