SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Saint Monica

27 August

Born in 331, she was the mother of Saint Augustine of Hippo. She was unceasing in her prayers to God.

Saint Augustine of Hippo

28 August

Born in 354 he had an unsettled hedonistic life until 387. He became Bishop of Hippo and for thirty four years lived an ascetic. He was a famous teacher by his writings. He died in 430.

Saint Aidan

31 August

Monk of Iona, the first Bishop and Abbot of Lindisfarne. Aidan came to England in 635 when Oswald, who had become a Christian, regained the throne of Northumbria from Mexican invaders. He was buried at Lindisfarne and the Parish Church of Bamburgh is the only ancient English Church dedicated to him.

Saint Edmund Arrowsmith SJ

30 August

Jesuit Priest and Martyr. Born in Haydock in Lancashire, he was ordained Priest in 1612. He joined the Society of Jesus.

He was arrested at Brindle, 16 Miles North East from Parbold. He was sentenced to death for being a Seminary Priest and was left chained for two days without food.

He was promised his life would be spared if he renounced his faith. He was executed at Lancaster on 28 August 1628.

A Portrait and a hand relic survives in St Oswald at Ashton in Makerfield, where cures believed to be miraculous have been reported.
