The Governing body of OLAS
School is consulting on proposed
changes to their School Admission
criteria to take effect from
September 2020.

The amendment is to comply with
The department for Education
Guidance that criteria 1 should
include children to appear to have
been in state care outside of
England and ceased to be in state
care as a result of being adopted.
There are also some amendments
to the notes for the purposes of
clarification of the criteria.
