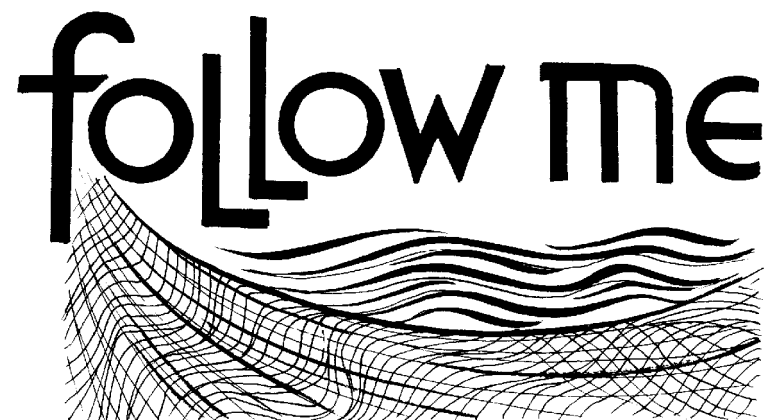

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Saint Cyril, Monk
Saint Methodius, Bishop

14 February

Cyril was born in Salonika
and was educated in
Constantinople, with his brother
Methodius, he went to
Moravia to preach the faith.

They both translated the liturgical
books into the Slavonic language
using the Cyrillic alphabet which
they invented.

They were called to Rome
and here Cyril died on
14 February in the year 869.

Methodius was made Bishop
and went to Pannonia
(Hungary) where he
laboured ceaselessly
in preaching the Gospel.

He died on 6 April 885 at
Velehrad in Czechoslovakia.
