SAINTS OF THE WEEK Saint Peter Damian Bishop and Doctor of the Church 21 February

Born in 1007, he became a hermit at Fonte Avellana after completing his studies.

He became the Prior of the community and strenuously promoted religious observance both there and in other parts of Italy. On his death, he was immediately venerated as a Saint.

Saint Polycarp Bishop and Martyr

23 February

Polycarp was a Disciple of the Apostles and Bishop of Smyrna, as well as a friend of Saint Ignatius of Antioch.

He suffered Martyrdom about the year 155, by being burnt to death in the City stadium.
