ANTHONY TROMP

Anthony Tromp is currently working as a volunteer at the Don Bosco secondary School in Didia, Shinyanga, Tanzania. Julie and Ged have just returned from visiting him.

The Children who attend this school all come from poor backgrounds, however the school is able to recoup fees from the families who are able to pay.

Unfortunately 75% of the population in the area are HIV positive resulting in many orphans who have to fend for themselves and are unable to pay fees. The school therefore looks for sponsors for these children in order to give them the best chance at an education. It currently costs 1.2 million Tanzanian Schillings per child to board at the school—this equates to £365.
