SAINTS OF THE WEEK

15 July Saint Bonaventure OFM

Born about the year 1218 at Bagnoregio in Tuscany.

He studied philosophy and theology at Paris, where he gained his masters degree, and then taught the students of the Order.

He became Minister General of the Franciscan Order and ruled with great wisdom and prudence, and later became Bishop of Albano.

He wrote many influential works in philosophy and theology and died at Lyons in the year 1274.
