PENTECOST

Pentecost was one of the Jewish pilgrimage feasts celebrated in Jerusalem.

It was originally a harvest festival feast celebrating the first fruits of the barley crop and in Jewish practice, it became associated with God's self-revealing at Sinai during the Exodus.

The bishop's liturgical greeting "Peace be with you" comes from the today's Gospel extract.
