MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL ABOUT REOPENING OF CHURCHES

The Archdiocese will be cautiously reopening some churches for the celebration of Mass from **Monday 6 July**.

From that date, Mass will be held at 10am at St Mary's, Skelmersdale every day. Our other churches will, for a short time, remain closed.

This is NOT a return to normal – we must restrict the numbers attending each Mass to ensure we have appropriate social distancing and health and safety measures will mean the Mass will have some changes.

The Archbishop has given permission for Masses to resume only if strict conditions are met – please help us to meet those conditions for the health and safety of all our congregation.

Please note the following:

one of the conditions of attending these Masses is that you must wear a face mask;
your Sunday obligation has not been re-instated, which means that any weekday Mass is considered to be a Sunday Mass; and
anyone who is vulnerable and does not want to return to Mass too soon are not obliged to do so.

SAINT THIS WEEK

4 July

Saint Elizabeth of Portugal

Born of King Peter III of Aragon in 1271. Known as 'the peacemaker', her humble disposition, devotion to God and life of virtue, made her widely respected at court.

At 12, she married the king of Portugal, and despite his religious indifference and infidelity, she was a devoted wife and mother.

She was well known for her charity to the poor, founding of a hospital and house of Poor Clares at Coimbra.

Accustomed to riding out into the battlefield to solve problems between kingdoms, she died in 1336 on a peacemaking mission.
