PETER'S PENCE

Peter's Pence is a worldwide special collection to support the international ministry of the Holy See, in particular its charitable and philanthropic work.

The idea of a special levy or collection to support the Pope's ministry started in England in Anglo Saxon times.

By the late Middle Ages, Peter's Pence was no longer a second collection but a tax, and when Henry VIII broke with the Church, it was abolished by Parliament.

In recent years, Pope Francis has given special attention to helping refugees. You may be interested to know that the Church is the largest provider of support for refugees in the world, after the United Nations.
