Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist

Called Levi by Mark and Luke, a tax
collector (publican) of Jewish race, he
worked for the Romans until leaving all
at the call of Jesus.

He is regarded as the author of the
Gospel bearing his name. His apostolic
activity was at first restricted to the
communities of Palestine, though there
are some traditions associating him with
Ethiopia, and other traditions
associating him with Parthia and Persia.

It is uncertain whether he died a
natural death or received the crown of
martyrdom. His Gospel was written to
fill a sorely-felt want for his fellow
countrymen, both believers and
non-believers .
