### SAINTS THIS WEEK

#### 8 September

#### Birthday of Blessed Virgin Mary

The Catholic Church celebrates the birth of the BVM on its traditional fixed date of 8 September, nine months after the 8 December celebration of her Immaculate Conception as the child of Saints Joachim and Anne.

The circumstances of the Virgin Mary's infancy and early life are not directly recorded in the Bible, but other documents and traditions describing the circumstances of her birth are cited by some of the earliest Christian writers from the first centuries of the Church.

#### 10 September

#### St Ambrose Barlow

An English Benedictine monk, born at Barlow Hall, near Manchester and educated at Douai and Valladolid. He was martyred for his priesthood in Lancaster in 1641 and is one of a group of saints canonised by Pope Paul VI who became known as the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales.

His relics are substantial and widely dispersed; his jaw bone, is kept at St Ambrose Church, Chorlton, Manchester and his skull is kept at Wardley Hall, the Bishop of Salford's residence.

#### 12 September

#### Most Holy Name of Mary

God the Father is glorified by the exalted role of the BVM. Thus, her name is one of honour; a holy name, a maternal name and a name responsive to the needs of the Church.
