### SAINTS THIS WEEK

13 October

#### St Edward the Confessor

Edward became King of England in 1042. His reign was peaceful and characterised by his good rule and remission of odious taxes. Edward endowed the construction of Westminster Abbey, where he is buried. His piety gained him the surname "the Confessor".

15 October

#### St Teresa of Jesus (Avila)

Founder of the reformed (Discalced) Carmelites, she showed religious piety from an early age. Entering the convent, she deepened her practice of prayer and meditation. She was misunderstood and ridiculed by those around her, due to her visions and other religious Experiences. She wrote The Interior Castle and The Way of Perfection.
