CESSATION OF PUBLIC COMMUNAL WORSHIP NOVEMBER 2020

Between Thursday 5 November and
Tuesday 1 December inclusive there
will be no acts of public worship in
our churches.

The only exception to this rule is that
funerals will be permitted with a
maximum of 30 people attending.
