THE ANNUNCIATION

Why is Mary's yes to God so important to us?

Through Mary's fiat, her "yes" to God, she made the Divine Plan of salvation effective in history.

SYNOD 2020

The Archbishop will then develop a pastoral plan that responds to the results of the Synod and this will be published in the Autumn.

The recommendations cover a broad range of topics including evangelisation, spiritual formation, governance, property, and the place of the Church in today's world.
