### PALM SUNDAY

Due to safety restrictions, The  
Commemoration of the Lord's  
Entrance into Jerusalem will be  
celebrated within the church rather  
than outside.

Therefore, the usual procession with  
palms into the church will not take  
place.

Instead, all the palm branches will be  
blessed by Fr Daley during the  
celebration of the liturgy and then  
distributed as people leave church  
at the end of Mass.

### GROUNDS WORK

Work will be taking place to repair  
storm damage to the culvert that runs  
through the church grounds alongside

### WHY IS PALM SUNDAY ALSO CALLED PASSION SUNDAY?

Although the Gospel account of  
Christ's triumphal entry into  
Jerusalem is read at the beginning  
of Mass when the palms are blessed,  
the Gospel of the Passion is then  
read at the usual place for the  
Gospel during the Liturgy of the  
Word.

This marks the solemn  
beginning of the commemoration of  
the Lord's Passion and Death.
