TRANSFER OF PARISH Whilst pastoral care for our parish was transferred from Ampleforth Abbey to the Archdiocese of Liverpool in May 2019, the transfer of trusteeship – the legal aspects, concerning the buildings and finance have taken much longer. However, this is finally due to take place on 30th September.

NEW PRIORY RESIDENT AND FUTURE USE We are pleased to announce, and warmly welcome the newly appointed Bishop Tom Neylon, who will take up full residence in the Priory from the beginning of October. Parbold is close to the geographical centre of the Archdiocese and will enable him easy access to all areas. The parish responsibilities for pastoral care, administration and meetings functions will continue to be met from the Priory.

ST VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY The parish SVP group is appealing to all parishioners for help. The St Vincent de Paul Society, or SVP for short, is a group of volunteer parishioners who set out to help anyone in need. Your assistance is needed. CREMATED REMAINS REMINDER Just to remind everyone that “ the scattering of cremated remains is not permitted by the Catholic Church; nor is it permitted to keep the ashes of a loved one at home. Remains must be reverently interred in good time after the funeral, either in a special grave, or the family plot”. (Extract from a Letter from the Congregation for the Doctrine of Faith 2016). There is special provision for ashes in our cemetery.

HOSPITAL CHAPLAINS NOTE If a priest is needed to minister to a sick person in hospital, in an emergency or for general spiritual support, the usual protocol is to contact the Hospital Chaplain. Hospital Chaplains are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and can be contacted via the ward staff.
