WORLD MISSION SUNDAY Today is World Mission Sunday. It is one of the three annual Papal collections when the entire global Church comes together to support mission. Coordinated by Missio, the Church's official charity for overseas mission, every single donation supports churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor. The focus this year is the work of the Church in Nigeria, a country threatened by conflict and instability, along with economic and social injustice. It is a country where religious affiliation is being used in a self-seeking struggle for power.

BEREAVEMENT SERVICE Following the celebration of the Feast of All Souls, we will hold a Bereavement Service with readings and hymns in Church, at 7.00pm on Thursday 4th November, to pray, reflect and remember loved ones who have died. Envelopes can be placed in the offertory basket or handed in at the Priory. They will rest on the altar during the whole month. The remaining Masses in November will be offered for individual intentions as usual.

MEETINGS RESUMED FOR PARISH GROUPS SVP and DVO met this week. It was the first meeting for SVP since February 2020, which proved to be a valuable opportunity to catch up with what members had been doing. It was DVO's second meeting in person; they have continued to receive referrals and to support asylum seekers throughout the pandemic, with protective measures in place.
