

BAPTISM Congratulations to George Hopcroft-Curwen, who will be baptised in our Church this Sunday (Private baptism). Please pray for George, whom we welcome into our parish community, and his family.

ASPERGES This is the rite of sprinkling the altar, clergy and congregation with Holy Water before Sunday Mass. It will be conducted this weekend to mark the restoration of the use of Holy Water - see review of Covid guidelines below. Fr Daley will bless the water and then sprinkle the congregation, using the aspergillum (brush or small handled perforated container).

QUARANT'ORE FRIDAY 25TH UNTIL SUNDAY 27TH FEBRUARY Come and savour the silence of Our Lord's Presence. The Church will remain open day and night for visits to the Blessed Sacrament and for private prayer. The altar will be awash with candles and flowers, and there will be prayer material available. Whether you want to call in for five minutes or spend a whole hour before the Lord, you are most welcome. See poster for more details.

PALMS The ashes used in the liturgy on Ash Wednesday are traditionally made from the palms used on Palm Sunday the previous year. If you have palms at home, which could be burnt for this Ash Wednesday, 2nd March, please could you bring them to Church during the week before. There is a basket available.

REVIEW OF COVID GUIDLEINES In light of the changing government regulations, the Archdiocese have reviewed their guidelines for collective worship, following advice from the Bishops Conference of England and Wales as follows: face coverings are strongly recommended in Church, Holy Communion will remain under one kind; Holy water can be restored; the Sign of Peace can be restored.
