So far this appeal has raised over £70,000 and this is increasing on a daily basis. DONATIONS OF GOODS UPDATE The archdiocese wish to thank everyone for their generous donations of goods. Due to the overwhelming amount received, they are no longer able to accept any more, except for medical supplies. On Tuesday, after travelling for three days, covering 1,400 miles and through six countries, drivers from the archdiocese arrived at the Polish border and successfully delivered the donated goods to Bishop Gregory Komar, and students for the priesthood from the Holy Spirit Seminary in the Ukrainian diocese of Sambir-Drohobych, who will distribute the goods in the Lviv region. Bishop Gregory is the auxiliary bishop of the diocese and has a close association with the Archdiocese of Liverpool. Please continue to pray for the drivers as they start their journey home.
