

ST BENEDICT This photograph of St Benedict has been taken of the stained glass window on the south side of OLAS Church. Born in Italy, around 480AD, while still a young man, he went to live in seclusion, at Subiaco where others, attracted by his way of life, joined him. Instead of the solitary search for God, he taught them to seek God together in community. That community however, did not appreciate the rigour of Benedict's way and tried to poison him. Legend says that when he blessed the cup of poisoned wine, it shattered miraculously. The raven, depicted in the window but not shown in this photo represents another occasion, when a priest, moved by envy, tried to poison Benedict with poisoned bread. When he prayed a blessing over the bread, a raven swept in and took the loaf away. Benedict left Subiaco and founded

instead the great monastery of Monte Cassino, where he wrote his Rule for Monks, his only surviving writing. Benedictine influence spread throughout Europe and the Order he founded is the oldest in the Catholic Church.
