

ST JAMES THE APOSTLE To the left is a photograph taken by our resident photographer, of the first stained glass window on the north (left) side of our church, depicting St James the Apostle. The window is in memory of James Ainscough (1858-1933) son of Hugh Ainscough, co-founder of the church. St James was one of the Apostles of Jesus and thought to be the cousin of Jesus himself, as the son of the sister of the Virgin Mary and the brother of St. Jude Thaddeus. He worked as a fisherman with his brother, John and his father, Zebedee. James and John were followers of John the Baptist and later, Jesus. Along with his brother John, he left life as a fisherman when Jesus called him to be a "fisher of men". He followed Jesus as one of his disciples until Jesus was crucified by the Romans. Following the crucifixion, James made a pilgrimage to the Iberian Peninsula to spread the word of Jesus. When he returned to Judea by pilgrimage, he was beheaded by King Herod Agrippa I in the year 44AD. The remains, or relics, of St James, were then transported by his followers to the Iberian Peninsula (today's Galicia in Spain) and are said to be buried in Santiago de Compostela, which is why St James is now the patron saint of Spain. He is also

universally regarded as the patron saint of pilgrims. The scallop shell became the recognised symbol of all pilgrims on the Camino, as it's found on the shores of Galicia. When returning to their own countries, pilgrims displayed the scallop shell on their hats to show they had carried out their pious intentions.
