CHURCH HEATING THIS AUTUMN AND WINTER The Finance and Fabric Committee met last week to discuss plans to manage the central heating and lights over the coming months, in view of the sharp increases in gas and electricity. Last year, the church central heating cost £3,300. The unit cost for the church will increase by 400% this year and unless we make some changes, the monthly cost of gas usage alone over the autumn and winter, will exceed our monthly income. One option would be to celebrate weekday Mass in a more enclosed area of the Church, and this is being looked into. Any final decision will be published in the newsletter.
